

Aldersly Reopening Plan – Summary

The following is a general overview of the Aldersly Reopening Plan. As the public restaurants, stores, gyms, and beauty salons go back into operations, state officials have made it very clear that Senior Living and Long-Term Care Facilities will not move at the same progression. Aldersly will incorporate a 3-Phase approach to the gradual start of the reopening of our community. Each Phase should last approximately 4 weeks, and we will only be able to continue to advance to the next Phase if we continue to maintain no positive cases of residents or employees with COVID-19.

Dining Services	Sit down dining areas remain closed. Take out available. Scheduled outdoor dining planned. No guests allowed.	Sit down dining areas open with limited seating. Staff wear masks. No buffet or self-service. Take out available. No guests allowed.	Sit down dining areas are open with average seating. Staff service of all buffets. Guests are allowed upon screening.
Activities / Community Life	ZOOM Weekly Meetings Small group (no more than 10) activities begin outdoors. Masks and physical distancing required	Small group (no more than 10) activities begin indoors. Masks and physical distancing required	Group activities resume as normally scheduled with proper physical distancing when possible. Large group activities may be held outdoors
Transportation	Available for essential travel only. No LYFT, taxi or rideshare is to be used.	Available for medical appointments and other scheduled activity travel. No Lyft rideshare used.	Scheduling of transportation resumes. Residents use the van for travel. No rideshare used.

Housekeeping	Linen service weekly. Modified quick clean of kitchen & bathroom Resident leaves or stays in alternate room. Resident masks are required, and staff wear mask and gloves. Work orders and scheduled maintenance continues as normal. Staff are required to follow physical distancing guidelines.
Package & Mail Delivery	Mail and Packages are delivered to the front office for distribution. Families drop off items at front office.	Package and Mail delivery happens as normal. Families may drop off items directly to apartment.	Package and Mail delivery happens as normal. Residents may pick up off-site packages.
Fitness Studio	Fitness studio remains closed.	Fitness studio is opened with limited hours. Physical distancing required.	Fitness studio is opened under normal operations. Cleaning occurs daily.
Salons	Salon is closed for hair and massage at this time. (May open following county orders with physical distancing and masks, both salon operator and resident). 1 resident at a time. No outside clients. No massage services.	Open following county and state orders with physical distancing and masks for both operator and resident. 1 resident may be allowed in the room. No outside clients. No massage services.	Open for massage and hair services based on no more than 1-3 residents in the room. Continue to follow county and state orders.
